Well structured wine with black fruit flavours and well integrated oak on the finish.

Elegant with ripe blackberry fruit, chocolate and pepper flavours with soft oak.

A classic New Zealand style of Pinot with brambly fruit aromas, cherries and plums on the palate with a good concentration.
